LCCC's Ohio Small Business Development Centers (SBDC) provide a high-impact, front-line program designed to facilitate small business growth, job creation and access to capital.

The Ohio SBDC Network provides assistance in access to capital (business loan assistance), buying or selling a business, management and HR, business plan development, government contracting, marketing, strategic planning, and more. Alonzo is a 2020 jumpSTART graduate who also participated in LCCAA's By Car Program. By Car helps income-eligible clients save their earned income toward a vehicle purchase.

The By Car program now matches their savings 3 to 1 up to a total of \$5,332. Participants take financial literacy courses as well as learning the costs of owning a vehicle and its proper maintenance.

jumpSTART participants may be able to use earned escrow, income tax, or stimulus money toward the purchase of a vehicle while enrolled in the By Car Program.

LMHA Opening HCVP Waiting List

The Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority (LMHA) will be accepting pre-applications for the Housing Choice Voucher Program waiting list. Pre-applications can be downloaded from www.lmha.org. Paper forms are available outside the front entrance of LMHA's Main Office, 1600 Kansas Avenue, Lorain, Ohio 44052. Completed pre-applications must be sent via US mail to LMHA, P.O. Box 1009, Lorain, Ohio 44055. Only one pre-application per envelope. Envelopes must be postmarked by April 30, 2021 to be considered for selection. Applications submitted by any other means or postmarked after April 30, 2021 will not be eligible. Only one pre-application accepted per household.

Upon receipt, LMHA will assign each envelope a ticket. On the first and third Friday of each month beginning May 7, 2021, LMHA will randomly select a pre-determined number of tickets based upon LMHA's operational needs. LMHA will contact those selected only by the phone, text, or email listed to begin screening for eligibility. Applications postmarked after the deadline and those not selected by August 31, 2021 will be disposed of on September 1, 2021. LMHA will not notify those persons.
