DEFINITIONS

Domestic Violence is defined as:

Includes felony or misdemeanor crimes of violence committed by:

- a current or former spouse of the victim; or a.
- by a person with whom the victim shares a child in common; or b.
- by a person who is cohabitating with or has cohabitated with the victim as c. a spouse; or
- by a person similarly situated to a spouse of the victim under the domestic d.
- by any other person against an adult or youth victim who is protected from that person's acts under the domestic and find the domest that person's acts under the domestic or family violence laws of the e.

Dating Violence is defined as:

Violence committed by a person

- who is or has been in a social relationship of a romantic or intimate nature with the victim
- where the existence of such a relationship shall be determined based on a b. consideration of the following factors:
 - the length of the relationship; 1.
 - 2. the type of relationship;
 - the frequency of interaction between the persons involved 3. in the relationship

Stalking is defined as:

- to follow, pursue, or repeatedly commit acts with the intent to kill, injure, a. harass, or intimidate; or
- b. to place under surveillance with the intent to kill, injure, harass, or intimidate another person; and
- in the course of, or as a result of, such following, pursuit, surveillance, or c. repeatedly committed acts, to place a person in reasonable fear of the death of, or serious bodily injury to, or to cause substantial emotional harm to:
 - 1. that person;
 - 2. a member of the immediate family of that person;
 - the spouse or intimate partner of that person 3.
